## FROM THE WHSLA PRESIDENT

Dear WHSLA Members:

All appointments to the offices and committees were largely the result of each individual's expressed interest in serving in that position.

I'd like to thank everyone who has volunteered to serve on a committee. We have many more volunteers for some of the committees than we have positions. We do, however, need one more person on the Legislation Committee. If you're interested, please let me know. I have a list of volunteers for each of the committees which I will refer to if I need to fill a vacancy or appoint a new committee.

It's going to be a busy year for WHSLA. The committees have all received new or revised charges. The By-Laws Committee will be reprinting and distributing the revised By-Laws. The Continuing Education Committee is again working with the Program Committee on the Annual meeting. They will also recommend guidelines for honoraria. The Guidelines Committee is developing a procedure manual--pulling together all the guidelines, the responsibilities and tasks of the Board members and committees. This will be completed by the annual meeting. The Legislative Committee's task is to keep WHSLA members informed on state, regional, and national legislation. Recruiting

is the Membership Committee's main objective along with recommending guidelines for payment of expenses. Planning and Development Committee will prepare a plan with short- and long-range goals for WHSLA. The Program Committee is planning our annual meeting for spring 1982 in Madison. We're also working on incorporating.

Area representatives are to be elected four months prior to the annual meeting to take office at that meeting. If you'd like to be the representative in your area, let the current area representatives know. Each area is to determine a procedure for electing/selecting area representatives. Mary will be the area representative until the annual meeting when the newly-elected area representatives join the Board.

#### WHSLA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MINUTES

The meeting of the Executive Board was called to order at 8:50 p.m. on Thursday, May 7, 1981 at the Todd Wehr Library, Medical College of Wisconsin.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

Members present included Mary Bayorgeon, Ellen Cooper, Eileen Emberson, Deb Gilles, Debbie Hall, Ruth Holst, Larry Jacobsen, Bill Nielsen, Joy Shong, Diana Slater and Ann Taylor. Guests present were: Barb Schmiechen and Al Zimmerman.

#### Treasurers Report

The current balance of the Association is \$6393.28. This high balance does not reflect the many expenses to be paid following the Annual Meeting.

#### Committees Membership

Deb Gilles reported that the membership of the Association is 104 as of May 7, 1981. Thirty members did not renew their membership for 1981. A brief discussion ensued about the reasons some members did not renew.

#### Program

Debbie Hall reported that preregistration packets were sent to 350 people. As of May 7, 77 people had registered for the Annual Meeting on May 8 and 54 had registered for CE courses.

#### Continuing Education

Ellen Cooper reported that the turnout for CE courses was good with no courses needing to be cancelled. Evaluations were also good. Barb Schmiechen reported that she had received feedback from both the ETN audiences and the CE Committee regarding program ideas.

#### Bylaws

Larry Jacobsen reported that the membership unanimously approved the two Bylaws Amendments which were recently voted on by mail. The results were also reported in the WHSLA Newsletter. Larry recommended that the Association have the bylaws reprinted with the new amendments added.

#### Ad Hoc Guidelines

Debbie Hall reported that the Guidelines Committee has not received much input from other committees. She suggested that they

may use a more structured interview approach to get the needed information. Officers were reminded that they too should write guidelines for their respective positions.

#### Legislation

Joy Shong reported that the Legislation Committee will continue to monitor important issues. Ruth Holst urged Executive Board members to monitor the progress of the proposed State Network Plan for multi-type library cooperation. Barb Schmiechen requested that the Legislation Committee help members keep up to date on the future of the Medical Library Assistance Act which is before Congress for renewal at this time.

#### Ad Hoc Planning and Development

Ruth Holst reported that the Planning Committee is working on its first charge of compiling historical data about the Association. President Shong urged members of the Board to contact the Planning Committee with ideas and suggestions for the future of WHSLA.

#### Old Business

Al Zimmerman passed out a summary of the Fall 1980 meeting in Marshfield.

#### New Business

Deb Gilles asked for volunteers for Secretary and Treasurer of the Association. President Shong informed Officers and Committee Chairman that they would be expected to give reports at the Annual meeting on May 8.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 p.m.

NATIONAL LEGISLATIVE NEWSProposed Rule on Medicare/Medicaid Participation Concerning Hospital Libraries

This proposed rule change, which would eliminate the requirement for libraries in hospitals as a condition for participation in Medicare/Medicaid, was explained in the October 1980 "Capital Notes" column. The Health Care Financing Administration received over 25,000 responses to all the proposed changes which had been outlined in the June 20 Federal Register, and staff members are still wading through them at this writing (April 30). No action is anticipated before the end of 1981.

IRS Ruling 80-60 (Thor Power Tool Tax Ruling)

On February 26, Senator Daniel Moynihan (D-NY) introduced S 578, a bill which would modify IRS Ruling 80-60. (See January 1981 Newsletter). This bill would be retroactive to the 1979 tax year and would provide a method for publishers and other companies to show evidence that their inventories have a low market value for tax purposes without destroying the inventory itself.

In the House, H.R. 1936 has been introduced to provide a straight exemption for publishers from this ruling. Both bills are pending in committees (Senate Finance Committee and House Ways and Means Committee). The Legislation Committee chairman wrote to these two committees and included the resolution passed by the MLA Board of Directors at its Mid-winter Meeting in support of Congressional action to exempt publishers from this ruling.

# Space Planning and Practical Design for Librarians

## PURPOSE

Work environments affect human performance. Good space planning and interesting interior design help maintain high levels of library employee morale, and make libraries more pleasant for the users.

The workshop is designed to help librarians develop in Boards of Trustees, college administrators, and corporate managers, an awareness of the problems of the libraries and of the librarians within their organizations. Unfortunately, libraries often receive funds last, and 'made do' is a phrase most commonly heard.

Participants of this course will study the elements of interior design and space planning especially pertinent to the library, with an emphasis on "do-it-yourself" techniques. Differing furniture and equipment layouts, lighting, color, and acoustics will be studied, as will the process of selection of furniture and other materials important to the planning process. Participants will explore methods of presentation of their libraries' needs to higher management. Obsolescence reports documenting current conditions and explaining projected changes, including in-depth analysis, will be explored. Students will learn to draw floor plans. One library will be studied in depth.

The course will be structured to foster maximum interaction between instructors and participants. Practical problems of space planning and interior design of the participant's libraries will be addressed. *Participants are requested to bring plans of their own libraries for critique.*

## ELIGIBILITY

This seminar is appropriate for librarians and other individuals who are interested in library space planning and design. The course is designed for top and mid-level library management with sufficient authority to implement the strategies developed in the course. The course is open to librarians in all types of institutions.

Enrollment is limited to 35 professional librarians or library administrators. Registration will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

## INSTRUCTORS

*Elaine and Aaron Cohen* are authors of the book **DESIGNING AND SPACE PLANNING FOR LIBRARIES: A BEHAVIORAL GUIDE**, published by Bowker. They have conducted more than 50 Space Planning Workshops across the USA, including the 1978 SLA Preconference and AALL 1978 conference. Workshops have been held at Columbia University, Rutgers University, for the states of Ohio and New Hampshire, and several were held for the California Library Association and the Metropolitan Council of Governments, Washington, D.C. As an architect and a behaviorist, Aaron and Elaine Cohen are well known as library consultants. They have worked on the Office of the President of the U.S., Oak Ridge National Laboratory, Upjohn Co., Univ. of California at Irvine and San Diego, Federal Reserve Bank of New York and San Francisco.
