STATE UNION LIST OF SERIALS FOR HEALTH SCIENCES

The holding statements from sixty-two libraries for the State Union List of Health Sciences Serials were sent to the University of Louisville in mid-November to be entered into the GMRMLN data base. Entering the data should take 4 to 6 weeks if there are no major delays at Louisville. (An update to this is that the material should be entered by mid-February.)

As soon as we are notified that the list is completely entered, an order form for fiche copies of the list will be distributed with the WHSLA Newsletter. The exact price of the fiche will be available at that time. We still estimate that the fiche will cost between \$15:00 - 20.00.

We won't know if the cost for print lists will be prohibitive until the data is all entered in the computer and we know the length of the list. We will make every effort to produce a print list for those wishing to have one, but it may not be possible.

If there is any library that was not able to get its material to the Committee by mid-November may still add its holdings to the State list. Contact me concerning the addition of your materials by the end of January.

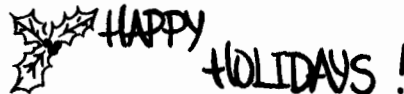
