NEW SERIALS LOCATOR LIST

The new Wisconsin Biomedical List of Serials is now ready for ordering. The materials is now completely entered into the data base at the University of Louisville. Included in this list is approximately 64 Basic Health Sciences Libraries in Wisconsin. The two Resources Libraries, Todd Wehr Library- Medical College of Wisconsin and Middleton Health Sciences Library-UW-Madison are not included in this resource. This has been a project of the Council for Wisconsin Health Sciences Libraries Network with Joy Shong chairing the Committee. Other members of the Committee throughout its history have been Mary Parrott, Betsy Merriam, Glenn Salter, Laverne Samb, Al Zimmerman, Eileen Emberson, Dorothy Kanter, and Helen Erke.

Full ordering information is elsewhere in this Newsletter. A \$5.00 charge is included within the full fee that will be used to reimburse COWL for its initial work for an OCLC generated serials list that the Council later rejected. A small segment of that fee will also be used for Council expenses. This is an important resource for Basic Library sharing. You are urged to have a copy of this list in your collection.

LIBRARY OF THE YEAR

Luther Hospital Library Services, Eau Claire, received the 1984 Clarence B. Lester Memorial Award for "Library of the Year." The award was presented October 26 at the Wisconsin Library Association's annual conference in LaCrosse.

Some of the items cited in the presentation were: "For its pioneering resource sharing with 23 community hospitals, for its unique interlibrary loan and reference services to public libraries in the Indianhead Federated Library System, and for its progressive use of microcomputer technology in the hospital library setting."

Eileen Emberson, former Director of Library Services, was commended for 16 years of innovative service. Eileen was on hand to accept the award along with Don Johnson, Vice President of Professional Services at Luther Hospital. Virginia Wright is the current director of the library and was also present.

COST CONTAINMENT ISSUES

Robert Peterson of the Institute for Health Planning, Madison, the speaker at the first Health Sciences Libraries Seminar November 7, included the following publications list in the handout. The informative session titled "DRG's, PPO's and other such acronyms" is available via interlibrary loan from Middleton's AV department.

a.k.a. P.P.O.: A Review of Selected Provider Arrangements. James R. Kimmey. November 1983. 42p. \$10.00.

Explores the new phenomenon of contracts among providers, employers, and payers to provide discounted health care to enrollee populations.

Altering Incentives in Health Care Delivery. December 1982. 51p. \$8.00.

Presents three strategies--prepaid health care, self-insurance, and preferred provider organizations--which modify underlying incentives in the health care delivery and financing system in the pursuit of cost containment.

Cost-Based Reimbursement: Health Care's Disease. Barbara W. Greenman. January 1982. 39p. \$8.00.

Analyzes the cost-based reimbursement system, which hampers cost control attempts, and the effects of health insurance on health care costs.

Cost Shifting: A Public Policy Debate. Barbara W. Greenman. February 1984. 39p. \$8.00

Presents a variety of interpretations of cost shifting; delves into its source; analyzes it in the context of rate setting, prospective payment, and tax policies; and concludes with a discussion of cost shifting, cost control, and equity.

The Dimensions of Health Care Reimbursement:
Selected Presentations from the Wingspread
Conference. June 1983. 154p. \$10.00.

Discusses current public and private initiatives in health care reimbursement reforms including the Federal perspective, Arizona's and California's competitive programs, diagnosis related groups, prospective payment, self-insurance, preferred provider organizations, and utilization review.

DRGs: Concept and Use. Larry Hartzke. August 1983. 104p. \$12.00.

Examines the basis of and need for measures of hospital case mix, describes the DRG case-mix classification system and its primary uses, and discusses the use of DRGs by New Jersey and Maryland and the recently legislated DRG-based payment system for Medicare reimbursement.

Medicare & Medicaid: Incremental Change in Health Care Financing. Greta Magill. March 1983. 88p. \$10.00.

Presents information on recent changes in Medicare and Medicaid legislation and the impact these changes have had on programs supported by Federal or state governments.

Private Health Insurance Coverage for Long-Term Care Services. Carol C. Oviatt. December 1983. 20p. \$8.00.

Highlights the major issues pertaining to private health insurance coverage of long-term care services for the elderly.

Proposals for Restructuring Tax Incentives for Health Insurance. Carol V. Getts. January 1983. 54p. \$8.00.

Discusses expected effects of nine proposals to restructure tax incentives for employer-based health insurance that were introduced in the 96th and 97th Congresses.

Prospective Rate Review. Barbara W. Greenman. July 1982. 31p. \$6.00.

Examines prospective rate review by discussing different methodologies, bases of payment, structural variants of review agencies, compliance and review criteria, determination of costs, extent of payer coverage, effects on capital accumulation, linkages between rate review and CON, and the current climate.

Recent Literature on Diagnosis Related Groups. July 1983. Free with order.

Cites the most recent articles and reports on diagnosis related groups (DRGs).

Third-Party Reimbursement: Barriers to Implementing Health Planning Objectives. March 1982. 20p. \$7.00.

Summarizes the Southeastern Association of Health Systems Agency Executives survey of health planning agencies on issues related to the reimbursement system that posed barriers to local health planning efforts, analyzes the identified issues, and provides recommendations based on the findings of the study.

CHANGE IN PROCESS

As of January 1, 1985, the Maude Webster Middleton Nursing Library is changing its focus. It is no longer the primary resource for the Edgewood College Nursing Program. It's goal is to become a hospital-wide Learning Resources Center for Madison General Hospital's Education Departments.

The Center will still contain the hospital's nursing collection. However, it is shifting many journal titles to the hospital's nursing units. Interlibrary loans are still possible, but some will take a little longer as they will need to be obtained from the units. The Center is dropping the following titles: The Australian Nurses Journal, Journal of School Health, Journal of Christian Nursing, The Lamp, Hospital & Community Psychiatry and Imprint. Several new journals, books and audiovisuals in the management, secretarial and inservice training fields have been added.

The LRC eventually will house many self-directed learning materials. The following independent learning modules are examples: "Dr. Blue" Review, IMED Infusion Devices, Infection Control, Safety, SOAP Charting and Introduction to Management. Future plans are to maintain independent orientation and inservice materials for all hospital departments, and purchase audiovisuals to supplement these modules. This, also, includes CAI's (computer-assisted-instruction), commercially and MGH produced. Temporarily, the Center is housing the hospital's Patient Education materials which include MGH produced aids, audiovisuals and pamphlets/booklets. "Maude's" services haven't changed, they've just expanded.

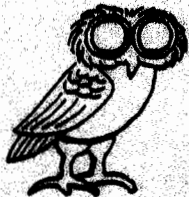
