MIDDLETON HEALTH SCIENCES LIBRARY ANNOUNCES INTERLIBRARY LOAN COST INCREASE

After many years of trying to maintain the same charges, Middleton Health Sciences Library is changing the prices for Interlibrary Loans through the Medical Library Service. This will be our first photocopy rate change since February 1, 1972 when prices were raised to \$.15 per page. New charges will be in effect on October 1, 1985 and will be guaranteed through December 31, 1985. Costs will be:

Photocopies	\$2.00 minimum per article
	Articles of 1-20 photocopied exposures are \$2.00 per request. Articles requiring 21 or more photocopied exposures will have an additional \$.15 per exposure added to the \$2.00 base price. (Example: 8 photocopied exposures = \$2.00; 22 photocopied exposures = \$2.30)

Original Materials \$2.00 per request
(Book, bound
journal, etc.)

The library will pay 4th class postage to send the material; requestor must pay return postage. Requestor has the option to pay 1st class postage to receive the material.

Rush Fee \$1.00 per request

At this time there are no other increases in prices. However, institutions both in-state and out-of-state may expect additional changes in prices in 1986. We regret this, but we are forced to raise our prices due to increasing costs in providing this service. NEWS FROM THE REGIONAL COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE

The Greater Midwest Regional Medical Library Network (GMRMLN) Regional Council met on April 3, 1985, in Chicago. Much of that meeting is reported in 3 Sources, 3(2): April, 1985 in the "Report of the RML Director" and "Regional Council Meeting News." In addition to those reports, the following information may be useful. The Wisconsin Council had requested that the Resource Libraries serials holdings be included in our State Union List. There is a concern that such a move would hinder the sales of the GMRMLN Union List. I conducted a poll to determine if Basic Health Science Libraries who are presently purchasers of the GMRMLN List would continue to purchase that list if Wisconsin Resource Libraries were included in our State Union List. Eleven of the sixteen libraries indicated they would still purchase the GMRMLN List. This information was reported at the meeting. After much discussion on the financial implications of including resource libraries holdings in state lists, the Regional Council voted to table a decision on this issue until the SERHOLD Task Force Meeting. I will report the results of that meeting when I receive it. Basic Health Science Libraries are encouraged to purchase the GMRMLN Union List. Cost of the updated list for 1985 is \$75.00.

Irwin Pizer, RML Director, reported on DOCLINE. Additional information is in the NLM News, 40(4), April 1985. Mr. Pizer stated that within five years even small libraries will be able to use DOCLINE. The holdings of the Wisconsin Biomedical Union List of Serials are automatically included in SERLINE by the University of Louisville for future automated ILL activity.

The State Resource chapters in the Basic Library Management manual are being updated. The new chapter will be available at cost from the Management Office in December 1985.

The Regional Online Union List of Monographs and Audiovisuals will be remounted by BRS to correct some of the problems. With limited funding available from NLM to pay the storage charges and limited use by libraries, it is doubtful that the List will be available online after remounting. Further information will be reported when known.

If you would like additional information or have questions about the April meeting, please call or write. I would be happy to talk with you.

The next Regional Council meeting will be held in conjunction with MC/MLA in Lansing, MI in October. If anyone has any questions, concerns or topics which you would like answered or discussed at that meeting, please contact me.

The Wisconsin Council Collection Development Committee reviewed the Collection Development Fund proposals in June. Notification of successful applications will be made in October or November by the GMRMLN Management Office. A report will also be published in this Newsletter.

NEW REFERENCE TOOL FOR NURSING

A new reference tool for the nursing profession is being introduced by the American Journal of Nursing Company.

Thelma Schorr, President and Publisher of AJN Company, today announced that a Nursing Citation Index, to be created by the Institute for Scientific Information (ISI), will be added to the INTERNATIONAL NURSING INDEX (INI) beginning in 1986. INI, a quarterly, has been published by the AJN Company since 1966.

The Nursing Citation Index will be similar to the well known Science Citation Index, which has been produced by ISI for over two decades. Citation indexing permits anyone researching a subject or author to determine each place an article has been cited in footnotes, references or bibliographies.

The INI indexes over 240 nursing journals from all over the world, as well as all nursing articles in the 2,600 other journals currently indexed for INDEX MEDICUS and its recurring bibliographies. The INTERNATIONAL NURSING INDEX is produced in cooperation with the National Library of Medicine, using the facilities of MEDLARS (Medical Literature Analysis and Retrieval System) and is the basis for the nursing information that is indexed in MEDLINE.
