HOSPITAL LIBRARY COLLOQUIUM TO BE HELD AT MLA

Something special is in store for hospital librarians at this year's annual meeting of the Medical Library Association in Minneapolis. On Saturday, May 17th and Sunday, May 18th a hospital library colloquium entitled "Opportunities Through Innovation" will be offered at the Minneapolis Plaza Hotel.

This colloquium has been a year in the planning and offers a good complement to the rest of the MLA Program this year. Major sessions include The Changing Structure of The Hospital Industry, Marketing, Technical and Personal Linkages and Interactive Management. According to Holly Shipp Buchanan, one of the planning task force, the panel of hospital administrators come from every type of hospital, Not-for Profit, Profit and "Going-it-Alone". All three viewpoints will be addressed.

For those librarians involved in Satellite Networks and responsible for Satellite Programs, Thomas Rasmussen from the Hospital Satellite Network will be speaking. Hospital Satellite Network is one of the most active and possibly the largest network in existence.

Although the colloquium is targeted towards advanced hospital library management topics, it offers something for everyone. For those of you who have already taken the C.E. 29 Course "Hospital Library Management" this colloquium goes one step further.

Ms. Buchanan emphasized that hospital librarians have choices in their position in the hospital structure. We can stay on the reactive side or we can become innovators and take a part in the course of our future within hospitals. Part of the process is taking a broader look at our management role and changing that role to meet the times. Interaction with our peers can lead to partnerships-linkages both on the technical and personal level. Evaluation of these linkages will help us, as hospital librarians, to grow.

This colloquium promises to address these topics and is being held apart from MLA Headquarters in Minneapolis as a special activity. This is a unique opportunity for hospital library managers. Registration fee of \$150 includes the sessions and a cocktail reception Saturday evening.

NEWSLETTER NOTES

The needs of a family grieving the loss of a baby during pregnancy or at birth are very great. Many parents are unprepared for their loss because it happens suddenly and they've had no previous experience with death. They feel confused and unsure of their immediate needs and what the loss will mean to them in the future.

Resolve Through Sharing is a La Crosse Lutheran Hospital-Gunderson Clinic support program for all parents who have lost a baby through miscarriage, stillbirth, or newborn death. It involves the disciplines of medicine, nursing, pastoral care and social services. The program also offers a parent support group.

The Resolve Through Sharing Staff have prepared a manual entitled "How to Develop a Comprehensive Perinatal Bereavement Program." A book "When a Baby Dies...Handbook for Helping", is currently being written by that Staff.

In the Literature

Stearns, NS & others. Literature to go. American Journal of Nursing 85 (October 1985) 1161-2. A review of a Patient Care Related Reading (PCCR) program, including study of nurses' response to this program.

Vaz, Dolores. An investigation of the usage of the periodical literature of nursing by staff nurses and nursing administrators. Journal of Continuing Education in Nursing 17 (Jan/Feb/1986) 22-26. The author's discussion of study results suggests that staff nurses report low usage of libraries due to time constraints, concluding that "library improvements...may not promote the outcome of increased literature use." Another quote - "The findings of this research suggest that placing journals on the nursing unit may be of greater utility to SRNs (staff nurses) than would be the increasing of library journal holdings." A challenge to hospital librarians to develop LATCH like programs as described in the Stearns article - these programs do get literature to the nursing units, while maintaining adequate access to nursing journal holdings.
