### AUTOMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE

### STATEWIDE NEWS

Northern  
The Learning Resource Center of St. Joseph's School of Nursing, Peg Allen Librarian, has moved into a new facility between the new hospital auditorium and the nursing administration offices. The library is now a MEDLINE center and will be participating in DOCLINE.

Western

Health care professionals in the Tri-State Area of Wisconsin, Minnesota, and Iowa can have access to the resources of the Health Science Library at Gunderson Clinic/La Crosse Lutheran Hospital 24 hours a day, seven days a week. They need only dial a toll-free Medlink telephone number and ask for QUICKSEARCH. During the library's regular hours, the Medlink operator promptly forwards each QUICKSEARCH call to the Health Sciences Library. After hours and on weekends and holidays, the operator records the request and holds it for pick-up as soon as the library reopens. Two of the library technicians have been specially trained by the Library Services director to assist in searching for materials. Materials are mailed within 48 hours of the request. The short turn around time is due mainly to the many hospital volunteers who work in the health sciences library. Journal articles that are available in the Health Sciences Library's collection are copied and mailed at no cost. A fee is charged for copies of journal articles that must be borrowed from other libraries. Area health care professionals are also invited to come and use the resources of the Library.

The Dean of the UW-Milwaukee School of Library and Information Science, Dr. Mohammed M Aman, was invited by the U. S. National Commission of Library and Information Science (NCLIS) to represent the U. S. National Committee for the UNESCO Federal Information Program as an official observer to the PGI Intergovernmental Council Meeting in Paris, France, November 17-28, 1986. The National Commission advises the U. S. President and Congress of National and international information and library policies.
