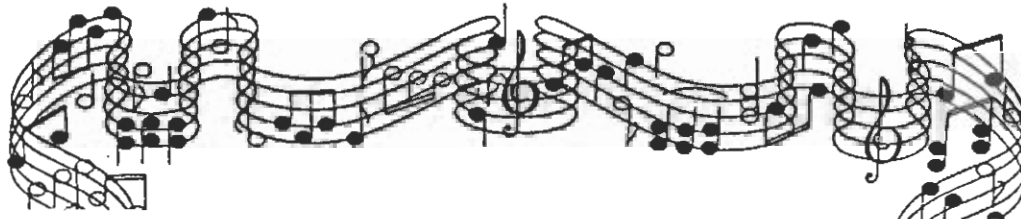
PATRICK BRENNAN and MARY BLACKWELDER will be teaching in Zimbabwe during the latter part of October and early November.
