WISCONSIN INTERLIBRARY LOAN AND REFERENCE REFERRAL SERVICES STUDY

The final report of the study of interlibrary loan and reference referral services in Wisconsin conducted by King Research has been submitted to the Division for Library Services and has been mailed to many state libraries. If you did not receive a copy, you may request one by writing to the Division for Library Services, P.O. Box 7841, Madison, WI 53707-7841, or calling (608) 266-3390.

The report contains much useful statistical and factual information on costs, referral patterns, timeliness, fill rates, and other factors involved in interlibrary loan and reference referral activities in the state.

Hearings were held in Rice Lake, Appleton, and Madison on March 28, 29, and 30 respectively, which gave interested individuals and groups an opportunity to respond to the study itself and to the recommendations of the consultants. Written comments may also be sent to Leslyn Shires by April 15. The Division staff will review the testimony and make recommendations to COLAND, which will then advise State Superintendent of Public Instruction, Dr. Herbert Grover.

The WHSLA Legislation Committee, WHSLA President Cindy Reinl, and Mary Bayorgeon, a member of the study advisory committee, participated in a conference call on March 23 to discuss the report and prepared a WHSLA response for the hearings. WHSLA members are urged to read the report and contact any of us or the Division for Library Services with your comments.
