CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by President Vicki Schluge, on Monday, September 18, 1989 at 5:17pm at the Pfister Hotel, Milwaukee.

MINUTES

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as written.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Pat Craven reported a current WHSLA balance of \$2474.14. Before beginning with other committee reports, Pat Brennan inserted that today's combined MC/MLA meeting should "break even." This was as expected since one main objective was to keep the cost down for each attendee.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Bylaws and Guidelines: Linda Oddan described the various changes in the bylaws. Most are simple changes in wording. Discussion on the number of Representatives-at-Large was tabled. In the interest of saving time and postage, a membership vote on the bylaws will be delayed until April of 1990. The following motions were offered and passed: 1. The WHSLA Board will be able to change the WHSLA Guidelines, but the membership must vote on changes in the WHSLA Bylaws. Sharon Wochos moved; Kathy Blaser seconded; carried unanimously. 2. The Treasurer as an appointed Board member will carry a vote only if he or she is also an elected Board member. Robert Koehler moved; Pat Wilcox seconded; carried unanimously. 3. The Annual Meeting Committee will not be limited to a one year term. B. Keppel moved; Sharon Wochos seconded; carried unanimously. 4. WHSLA will compensate the Chairman of the Annual Meeting Committee for his or her registration and official meals. Alana Ziaya moved; B. Keppel seconded; carried unanimously. 5. In the WHSLA Guidelines under Online Users, (p.33) delete the words, "include a NLM update session". Robert Koehler moved; Kay Wagner seconded; carried unanimously.

Continuing Education: Jackie Glick reported that there seemed to be no great interest in MLA "canned" courses. Attention will focus on quality assurance and organization and management courses. (no written report).

Planning: Kay Wagner reported on the choice of a plaque for Barb Schmiechen as the first "Librarian of the Year". The committee submitted a "rough draft" of some general guidelines for future awards. Motion Offered: Include finalized guidelines for awards in the WHSLA Guidelines. Kathy Blaser moved; Alana Ziaya seconded; carried unanimously.

Online Users: Shirley Gronholm reported that four programs will be offered this fall: Advance Searching; Review of MEDLARS; Database Potpourri; and CD-ROM.

Membership: Pat Wilcox reported a current WHSLA membership of 141.

Legislative: Mary Kotschi sent a written report highlighting a proposal from DLS for "Multitype Library Cooperation at the System Level". The committee will report its recommendations to the Board.

1990 Program: Robert Koehler reported that the keynote speaker will be Barbara Quint, editor of Database Searcher and a columnist for Wilson Library Bulletin.

1991 Program: Cindy Reinl reported that the 1991 WHSLA Meeting will be held May 1-3, 1991, in Green Bay at the Embassy Suites Hotel. The Board will plan to meet the Wednesday night before.

OLD BUSINESS

CWHSN OCLC Update: Robert Koehler stated that this issue would be discussed at length at the meeting of the Council. (Note: See Council Minutes in the October, 1989 WHSLA Newsletter.)

NEW BUSINESS

WHSLA Business meeting: Vicki Schluge asked that each Committee Chair give a brief report. Barb Schmiechen's picture as Librarian of the Year will appear in the WHSLA Newsletter. (For full minutes of this meeting, contact B. Keppel.)

Spring WHSLA Board Meeting: Tentatively set for the evening of Wednesday, April 25, 1990.

DOCUSER REMINDER

Do you ever need to find the address or LIBID of another DOCLINE user? One source to search for such directory information is the ELHILL database, DOCUSER (Document Delivery User). DOCUSER contains descriptive information about libraries and other organizations which use NLM's ILL services or are a part of the regional document delivery network.

The DOCUSER database may be accessed in the NLM system by typing either "File Doc" or "File Docuser" charges are assessed according to the same algorithm as is used for MEDLINE. The record for an organization may be retrieved by searching the NAME field directly, by performing a NAME WORD search or by TEXT WORD searching. Searching by NAME WORD (NW) is similar to TEXT WORD searching, except that the search is limited to information in the NAME (NA) field. The following are two examples of searching in DOCUSER. The first is the NAME (NA) search and the second is and NAME WORD (NW) search.
